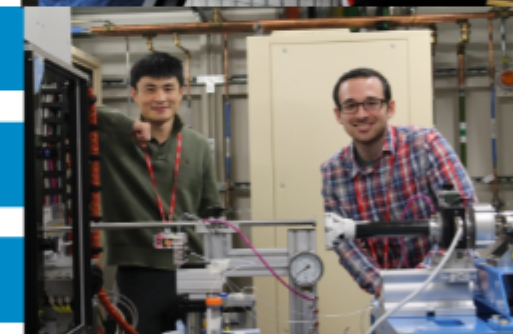

- South Africa ETA grants decrease from 10 (AY 2020-21) to 4 (AY 2021-22)
- Unwelcome decrease in applications received for South Africa (S/R and ETA)
- Applicants/grantees to all countries need to be adaptable, patient, and mature

Regional Trends

Grantees should be flexible, adaptive, patient, culturally sensitive, and self-sufficient.

- Most countries within the region require government and/or research clearances.
- Most applications and grants go to Jordan, Morocco, and Israel
- Israel PhD grants decreased from 6 to 4
- Morocco ETA grants decreased from 12 to 10

Regional Trends

ETA in Colombia: From 80 **up** to 100

S/R in Colombia: From 8 **up** to 10

Grant Period now from 6-10 months

Graduate students conducting thesis research now **strongly preferred**

ETA in Argentina: From 17 **up** to 20

S/R in Argentina: Bachelor's candidates *should* have at least **one year of post-graduation professional experience** at the time of application.

ETA in Brazil: From 80 **down** to 40

Applications accepted for Nicaragua; status of program constantly being evaluated.
