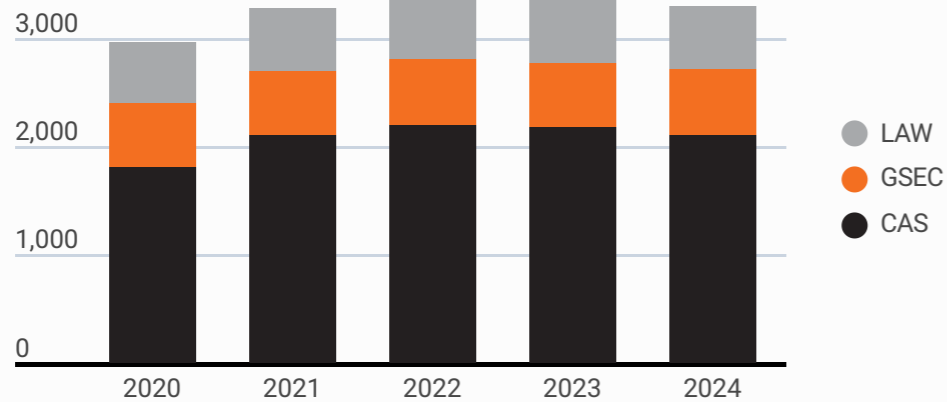

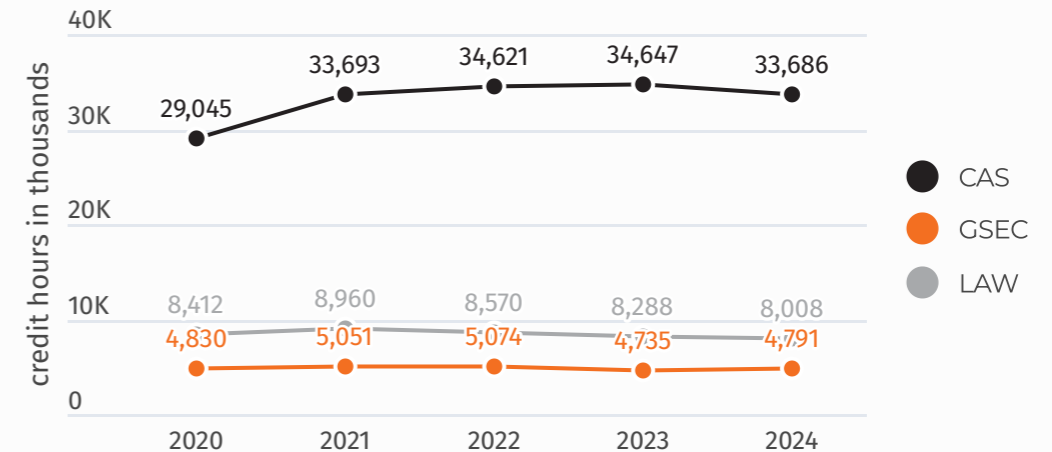

Credit Hours by School- 5 year trend



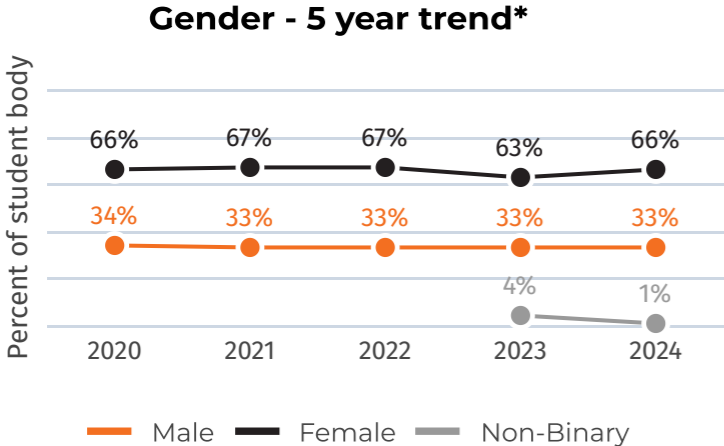

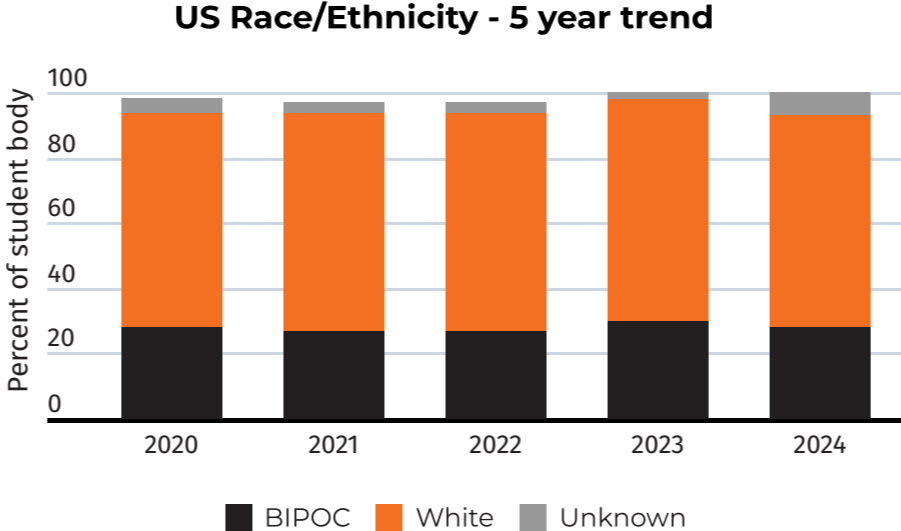

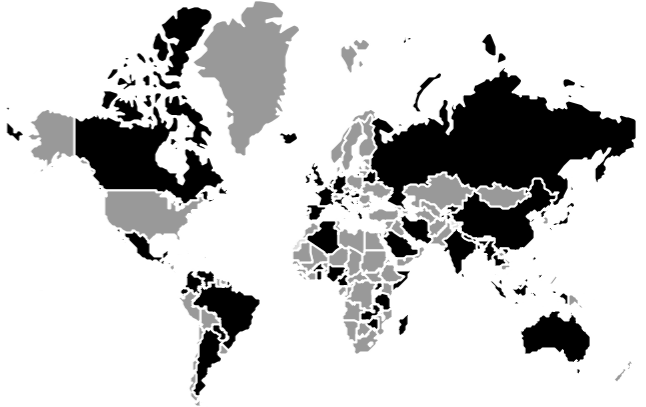

International enrollment (4.6%) has rebounded since the pandemic (3.3%) but still remains lower than the pre-pandemic level (5.4% in 2018)







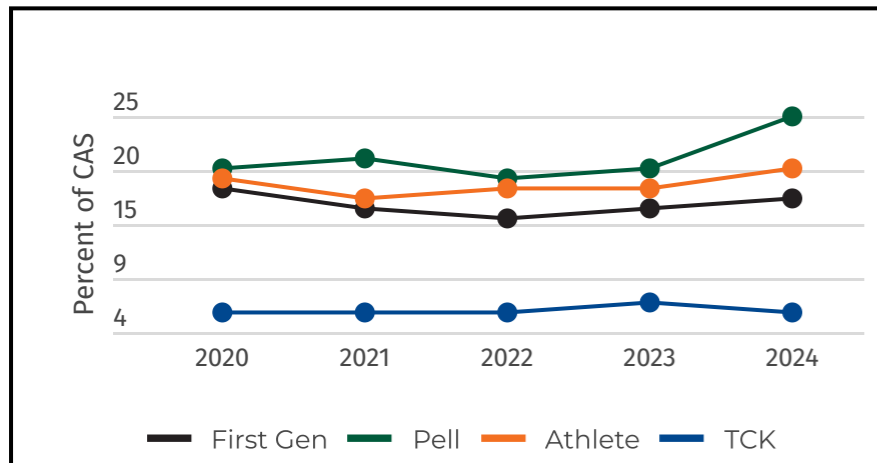

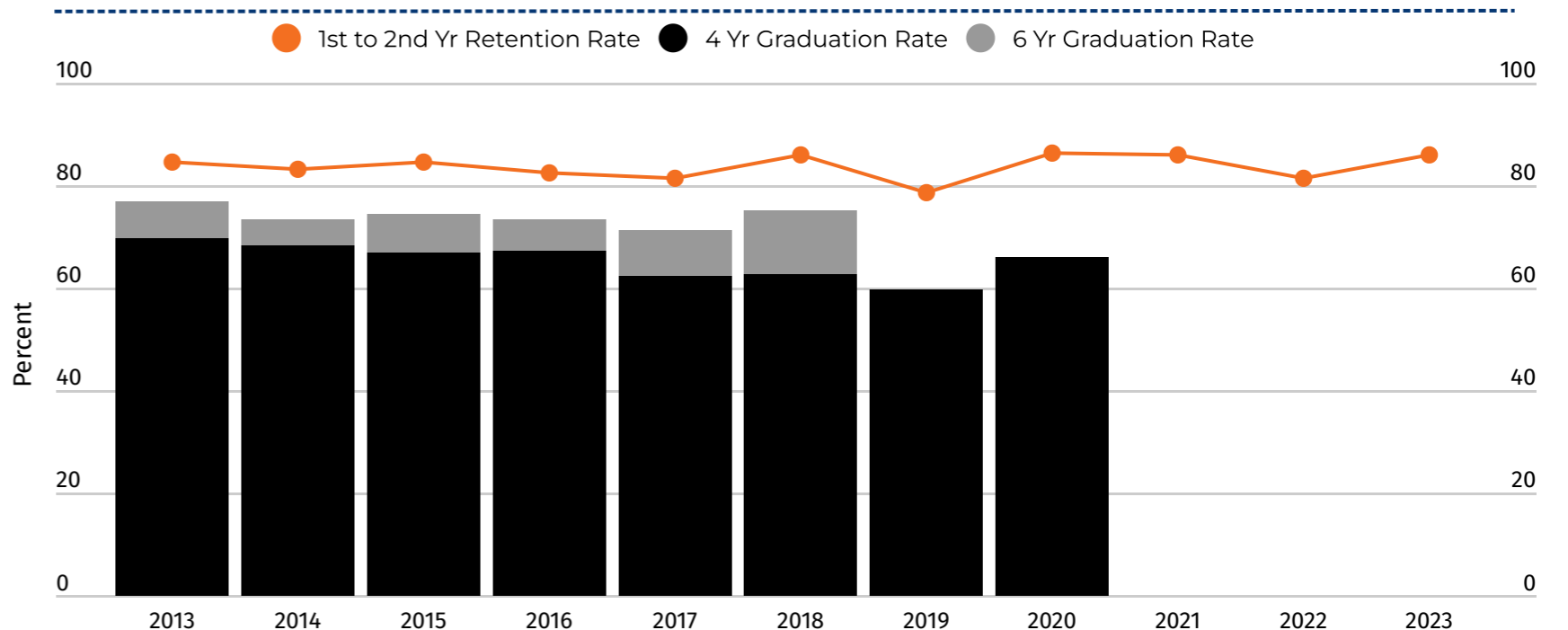

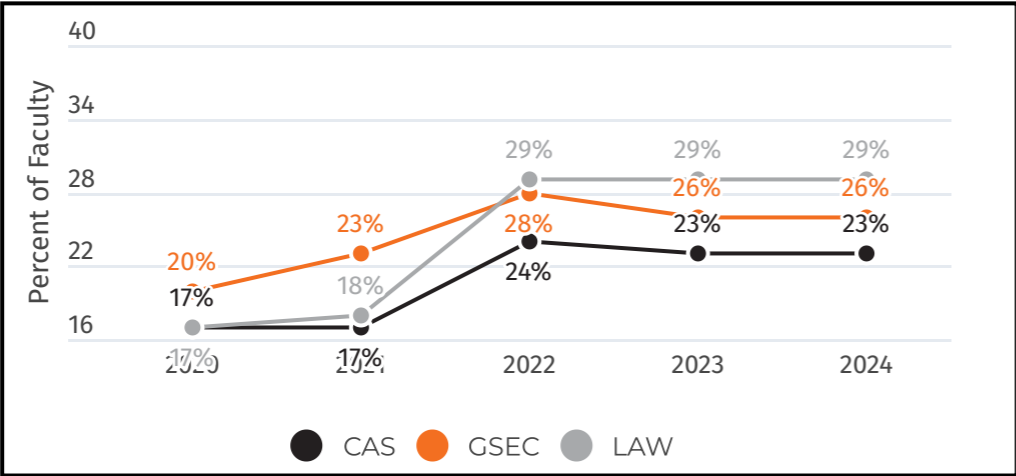

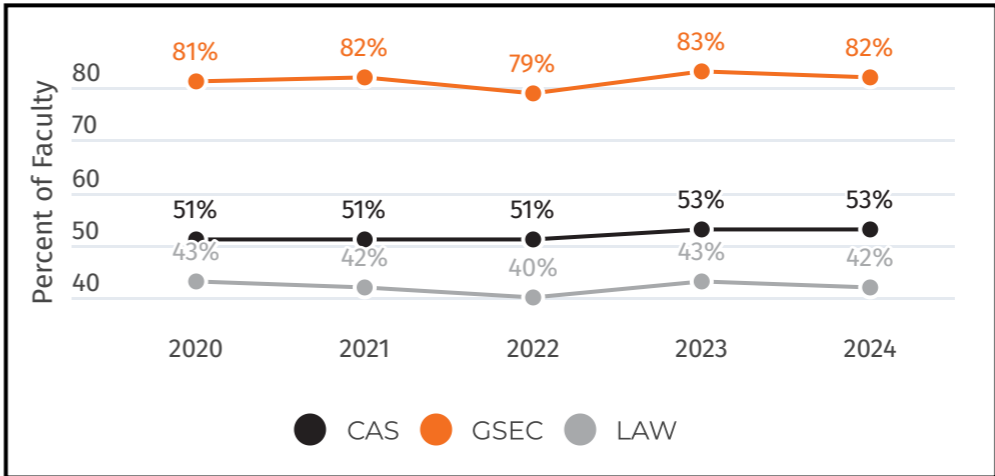

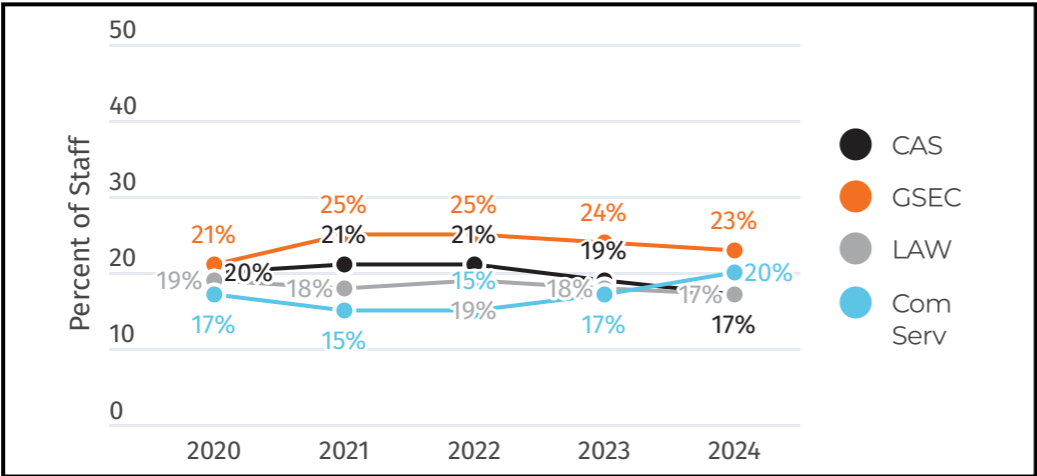

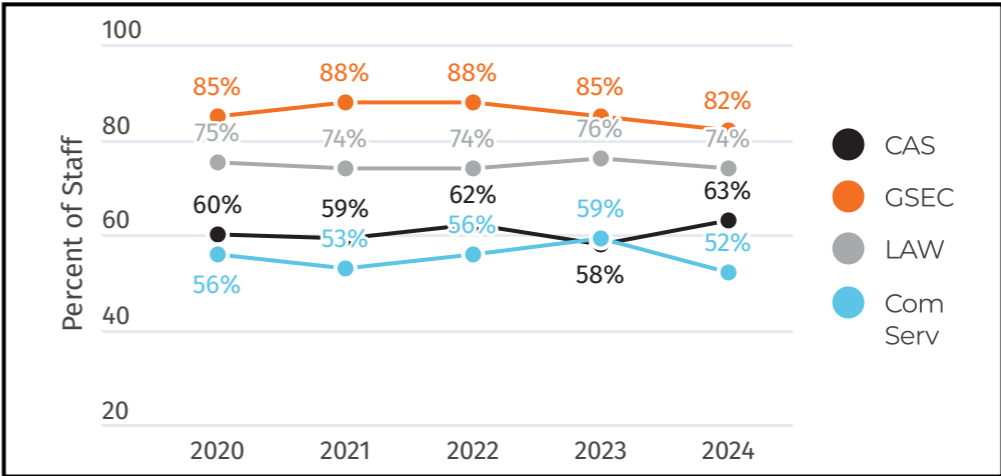
